

INTERESTED IN SERVING ON VESTRY?

Eligible candidates must:

- be baptized;
- be 18 years of age or older;
- be registered parishioners;
- in the previous 12 months
 - have regularly attended worship services (and received Communion)
 - have made a financial pledge to the parish

What is this servant leadership that is Vestry?

The Church defines the Vestry as “the legal representative of the parish with regard to all matters pertaining to its corporate property.” Three responsibilities are often articulated for the Vestry: “1.) to select the rector; 2.) to ensure effective organization and planning; and 3.) to manage resources and finances.” These are expressions of a calling that is spiritual. Indeed, the Vestry works closely with the Rector to “define and articulate the mission of the congregation” and its members make a sacred commitment “to support the church's mission by word and deed.” It is a one-year commitment, renewable for two more years, for a total service of three years. After a pause for one year, it is possible to serve again.

Approval of Vestry candidates will take place at our Annual Meeting (June 7).
